Storing some vulnerable formats? Concerned about transfers?

We are constantly reminded of our industry's "lack of support" for formats considered non profitable due to modern alternatives. As skill sets and engineering support slowly dwindle the options open to archivists are ever decreasing. With 1", 2", D3 and Umatic already unsupported what next? Sony has now announced the closure of support for betacam SP. Time really is against us!

TVP Archive, through its transfer facility JCAtv, can service all major formats both ageing and current.
